Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 is a chance to learn greater independence skills and prepare for the move to secondary school. These learning opportunities will be a focus in our class throughout the year. If your child walks to school or walks home from school on their own and has a mobile phone, the attached consent form should be completed and returned to the school office please.

Where children have their own devices at home, we encourage parents to take an active role in checking these devices, apps, messages and platforms regularly. We will be discussing our Acceptable Use agreement with the children in class and ask that you discuss these safety guidelines and age ratings with your child. Homework

Homework will be given out on a Thursday and must be handed in by the following Tuesday. The children will have spelling, reading, grammar and maths homework to complete. Maths activities will be in line with the class maths curriculum, and spelling will continue to follow the CUSP scheme.

Children should be reading every day, filling in their reading diary and returning it to school each day. They will have opportunities during the week to change their books. During the school holidays, I may set the children a task relating to their history, geography or art topic. I will email this information to you when I set this work.
